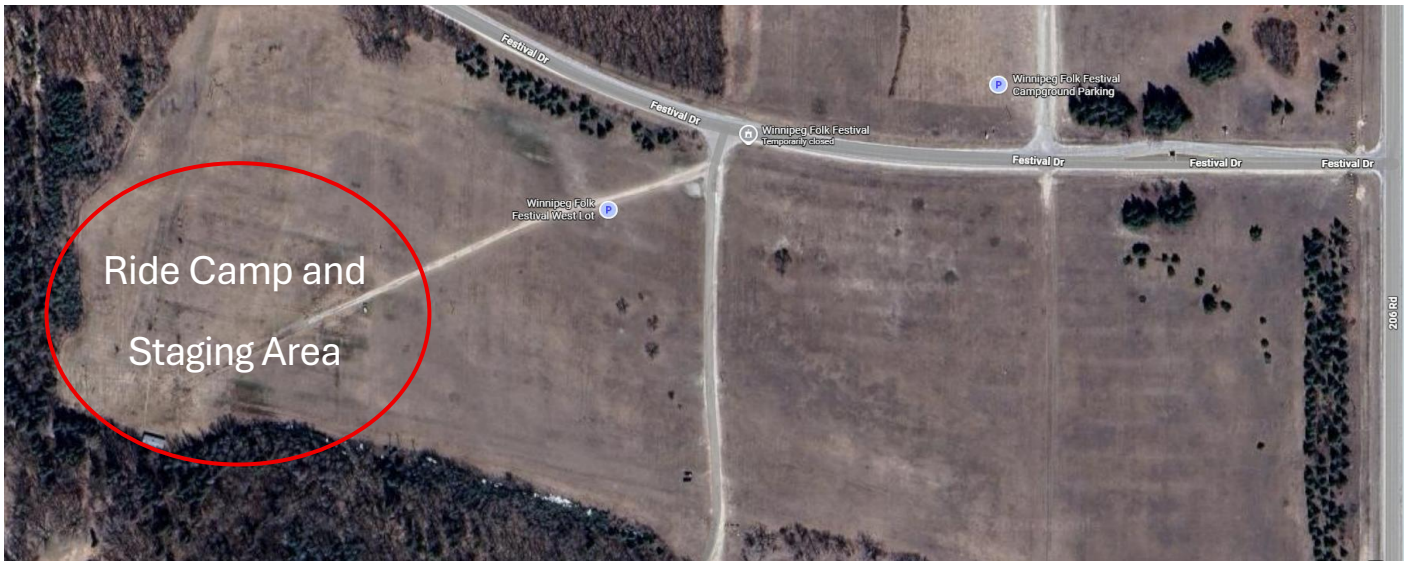


Birds Hill Boogie – June 6-7, 2026 - Biosecurity Protocol

Birds Hill Boogie – June 6-7, 2026 - Biosecurity Protocol

General

- There is a veterinarian onsite during the competition. All equine competitors are vetted in prior to participating in their division. Daily temperature checks on all horses is recommended.
- No animals with known communicable diseases should attend the event.
- All horses on site must have valid negative coggins test. Test results must be submitted at time of registration.
- All manure and wasted hay or other feeds must be packed back into trailers and removed at close of competition.
- Water troughs are communal and to be used at own risk. There is a tap with equine-safe water that can be used if preferred.
- Site will be inspected via walkthroughs by ride management and/or technical delegate.

Sick equines must be reported to officials and/or veterinarian. Clinical signs of sick equines to watch for:

- An equine with a body temp of more than 39°C
- An equine that is itaxic or recumbent
- An equine that demonstrates either aggressive behaviour or stupor
- Abnormal nasal discharge
- Persistent cough and/or laboured breathing at rest
- An equine with diarrhea, and/or
- An equine with oral or coronary band vesicular or ulcerative lesion(s)

Should an equine be noted with one or more of these symptoms, they will be removed from competition and asked to leave the ride camp area.
